Conferences & Workshops

At the following conferences and workshops in 2022, contributions are planned that will present the ETAT project:

- 14th International Conference on Knowledge and Smart Technology (KST), January 26 - 29, 2022, Burapha University, Chonburi (Thailand)
This conference will host a full ETAT workshop from 08:00 – 17:00 on January 27, 2022 with 10 presentations from the ETAT Thai partners.
- IEEE Global Engineering Education Conference (EDUCON2022), March 28 – 31, 2022, Tunis (Tunisia)
The project partners CUAS and EWA will present the ETAT project in a contribution (Speech & Paper).
- European Annual EduNet Conference, June 07 – 10, 2022, Paris (France)
At this conference it is planned that the partner EWA will report on the status of work in the ETAT project.
- Multiplier Event ETAT with other EU projects, June 21 – 22, Bolzano/Italy
The plan is to organize an EU synergy conference with the EU project EU H2020 MSCA RISE "SME 4.0 - Industry 4.0 for SMEs" and the two ERASMUS projects ETAT and ICARUS, which will be organized by the project partner UNIBZ.
- ISM 2022 - International Conference on Industry 4.0 and Smart Manufacturing, November 2 – 4, 2022, Linz (Austria)
The plan is to present in a special track on Engineering Education 4.0 also the ETAT project and invite ETAT partners to participate and to contribute with papers. ETAT representatives are involved in the special track as track chair.



Demonstration of project materials to stakeholders

After the opening of the ETAT training and education centers in the Thai partner universities, it is planned that a workshop (a total of 6 workshops) with interested industry representatives will be held at each university in the second half of the year. At these workshops, the ETAT project and the training services offered by the respective university with the ETAT Smart Labs for the industry will be presented.

Publication activities

The project plans to publish a study book with around 350 pages in English based on selected ETAT learning documents. This textbook is intended to be used primarily for work in the ETAT training and education centres. In addition, this textbook should also be distributed in general for training and training on Automation 4.0 in the East Economic Corridor. The necessary preparations for this study book should start in the second half of 2022.
